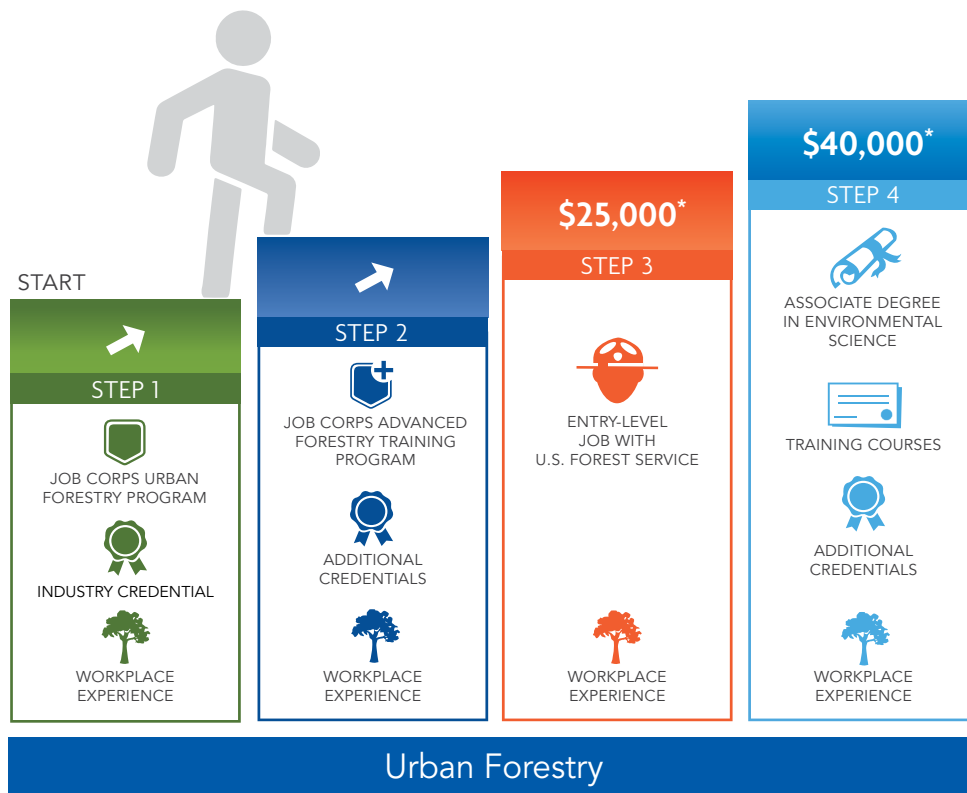


Salaries for entry-level jobs in Renewable Resources and Energy range from \$23,000 to \$42,000.*
