- Have completed either Job Corps' basic Computer Technician or Office Administration career technical training program.
- Have a positive attendance and progress record.
- Have health clearance from the Job Corps center where they received basic training.
- Complete a successful phone or in-person interview.



- Exercise good customer relations skills.




