At Job Corps, you can train in a variety of high-growth Automotive and Machine Repair career areas.

All training programs are hands-on, and you will train in real work environments.

Students also have access to training and academic classes with local community colleges and/or technical institutions through partnerships with the Job Corps Centers.

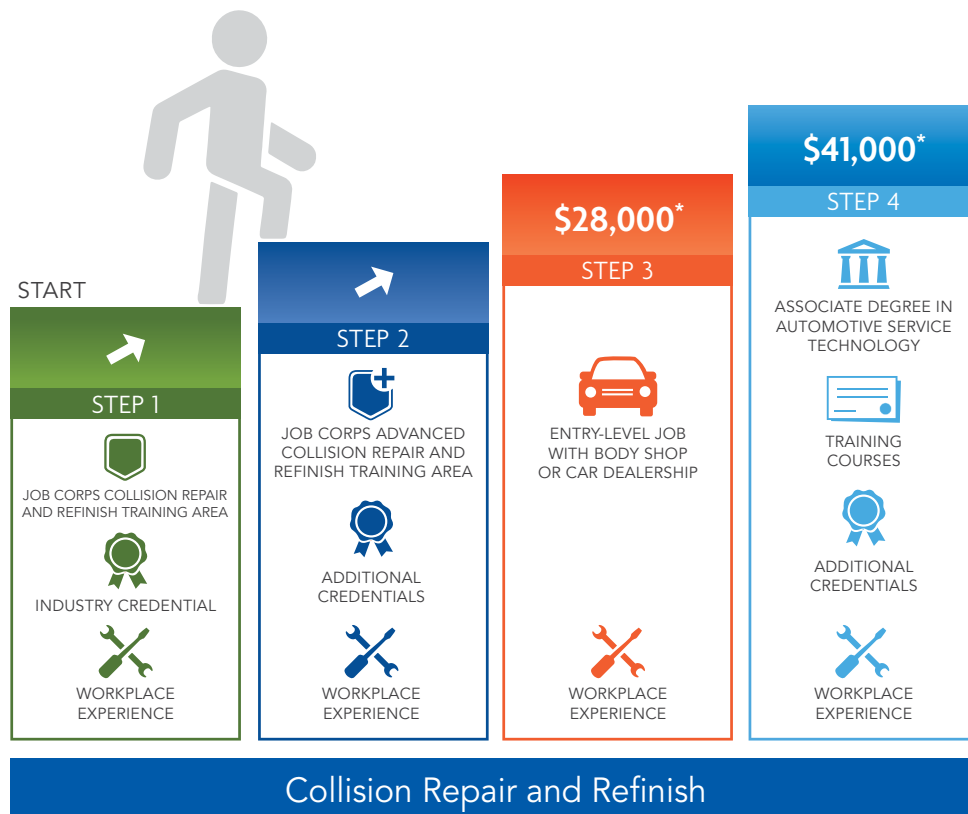


Salaries for entry-level jobs in Automotive and Machine Repair range from \$28,000 to \$40,000.*
